No kitchen facilities are available in the clubhouse. There are camping cabins, rustic and full service, available at the park for those who cannot bring their coach, call Mary for details and prices. There are also numerous hotels in Leavenworth. Check-in time at the park is after 1 pm on Thursday and check-out is 11 am on Sunday. When arriving please stop at the office for your site assignment and check-in information. Please bring a tow car if possible.. Sign-up sheets for those needing a ride to town will be available, donations to drivers for gas would be appreciated.

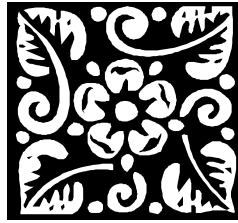
Pets are welcome but must be leashed and all waste must be picked up. Pets are not allowed in any buildings.

Directions: Leavenworth is located on U.S. Hwy 2. From Hwy 2, turn onto Icicle Road which is one mile west of downtown Leavenworth, (turn right 1 mile before town if coming from the west and turn left one mile after town if coming from the east). Follow Icicle rd. for approx. 2 miles, go just past the Sleeping Lady Resort, and the rv park entrance is on the left.

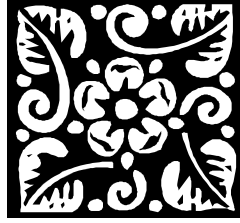
